

New Freight F-Units for N scale!

The F-Unit is probably the most recognized diesel locomotive in North American history. While many F3's were built for Passenger service, it was not uncommon for them to pass on to freight service later in life, even in some cases retaining some of the passenger details as they were refitted and repurposed for freight use.





Union Pacific Freight

The "Route of the Streamliners," started accepting delivery of Electro-Motive F3 locomotives in 1947. Originally intended for passenger service but later displaced by more powerful E8 locomotives, several F-Units received freight pilots as they continued performing dual roles for the UP.





Southern Pacific "Black Widow"

The SP owned 80 F3A and 80 F3B units, part of its move to diesel after 1947. Interestingly, F units such as the F3 made up the entirety of the Southern Pacific diesel fleet up until the mid-fifties.





Chicago, Burlington & Quincy

Built for passenger use on the California Zephyr, the CB&Q's final batch of F3s were bumped from Zephyr service in the 50's and found themselves re-geared and repainted into the CB&Q's freight white paint, although they maintained many of their passenger locomotive characteristics.
